Chania (IPA [xa'ɲa], Greek: Χανιά, also <u>transliterated</u> as *Hania*, older form *Chanea* and <u>Venetian</u>: *Canea*, <u>Godart and Olivier</u> abbreviation: KH, <u>Ottoman Turkish</u>: ويُن اخ *Hanya*) is the second largest city of <u>Crete</u> and the capital of the <u>Chania Prefecture</u>. It lies along the north coast of the island, about 70 km west of <u>Rethymno</u> and 145 km west of <u>Heraklion</u>.

The official population of the municipal area is 53,373 but some 70,000 people live in the greater area of Chania.
