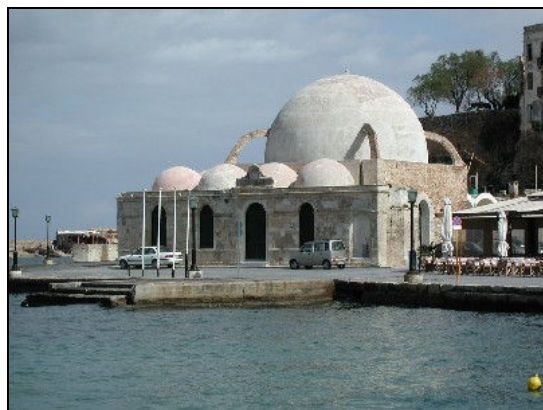

Chania (IPA [xaˈɲa], Greek: Χανιά, also transliterated as *Hania*, older form *Chanea* and Venetian: *Canea*, Godart and Olivier abbreviation: KH, Ottoman Turkish: هیناخ *Hanya*) is the second largest city of Crete and the capital of the Chania Prefecture. It lies along the north coast of the island, about 70 km west of Rethymno and 145 km west of Heraklion.

The official population of the municipal area is 53,373 but some 70,000 people live in the greater area of Chania.
